### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK...

As the summer flies by we are working hard to also fly through the storyline of the Old Testament on Sunday mornings at Zion. In July we explored the books of Numbers, Joshua, and Judges following Israel's journey from receiving the Law at Mt. Sinai to their settling into the land God promises to give to them. What was particularly on display in all three of these books was the striking contrast between the complete faithfulness of God and the utter unfaithfulness of his people. This

contrast served to drive home the truth that the only reason any of us can have a relationship with God is because of his kindness, patience, mercy and grace and not because we deserve his love. All throughout our study of the Old Testament storyline we have no-

ticed promises and pictures pointing to the coming of Jesus as the Savior God knew would one day die to take away our sin.

As we move into August, I am excited to share the stories found in 1 and 2 Samuel and 1 and 2 Kings. Familiar stories about King David and the prophet Elijah along with some obscure stories about other kings and prophets will provide further insight into the ways

the one true living God has always remained fully in control of the world he created. He shows himself to be a solid rock for those who trust in him by providing both protection from danger and forgiveness for sin. He also shows himself to be a formidable enemy to those who defy him by bringing about the judgment he warns about when his people turn from him. These books will end with the nation God created experiencing his wrath by being defeated and taken captive by its enemies just as God

> warned would happen. They also serve as the setting for the writing of many of the prophetic books of the Old Testament which point much more specifically toward the coming, the death, and the resurrection of Jesus the Messiah.

On July 5, we welcomed Jim Schmall from The Gideons International to speak in both services reminding us of the power of God's Word to change lives. Zion has always been grateful for the work the Gideons do in distributing Bible throughout the world and were blessed to have Mr. Schmall share with us. I also want to thank both Scott Powell and Randy Stricker for being willing to help lead the opening part of both services while I was out of town on that Sun-

I hope that our focus on praying for Muslims during their holy month of Ramadan was also a time of reflection for all of you. Let's commit to praying for Muslims throughout the coming year.

Our missionaries in Cameroon, Jeff and Sheryl Brown, have recently decided to transition out of ministry as you many remember from their letter on the mission table several weeks ago. They were ministering to Muslims in Cameroon and sent an update

from their co-worker, Patrice, who will continue with the same work. In light of our focus on praying for Muslims during Ramadan last month, I would like to share a couple of highlights from Patrice's letter.

"Dear friends and partners in the Lord's harvest,

We thanks you so much for all your prayer support to us during our prayer outreach in Briqueteri. We really experience God's protection and direction as we were prayer walking in Briq during the last 10 days of Ramadan. This was surely the result of your prayers, may the Lord's favor and mercy be to you all in Christ name.

I share to one of my Muslims friend Mohammed that I was fasting and praying during the last 10 days of Ramadan for God to reveal himself to the Muslims Briqueteri. He was very pleased with that news, and he invite me to come and break the fast with them during one of the evenings. The same day he also invite many of his friends muslins (6 men) among them was 2 Imams. When we were eating, he said to his friends, "Patrice (that is me) is a very good friend of me, almost like a brother now, as you know, good friends always want to give the best that they have to their friends, so Patrice is trying draw me to Christianity and I am also trying draw him to Islam."

I encourage you to find his letter on the mission table and read the rest of his story about his opportunity to impact the men he mentioned above.

This month, our prayer partners are focused on local ministries which offer a great opportunity to explore ways to get involved at the start of the school year.
